### LOT 1527

A Wileman & Co Foley china part tea service, late 19th century, decorated in the Imari palette with floral panels, comprising two cake plates, twelve sandwich plates, eleven cups and saucers, a milk jug, a slop bowl and two tapering square pots, printed and impressed mark to base, together with a yellow glazed pottery mug (minor faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

### Condition Report

1527 Service:

Slop bowl - faint hairline to base.

Jug - faint hairline to handle.

Plates - two with small chips to underside of rim.

Square tapering pots - one with hairline crack to base and crazed, the other crazed.

Saucers - four crazed, two of which are also discoloured.

Cups - two with hairlines, two crazed and stained, others with minor crazing.

Other pieces ok, overall some wear to the gilt particularly on high points.

Yellow mug - some overall wear to the silver rim and handle, otherwise ok.
