A late 19th century ebonized and bouille work bonheur-du-jour, decorated with overall panels of red stained tortoiseshell and brass within gilt metal borders, fitted with a pair of doors and two drawers, the base with a single frieze drawer enclosing a writing surface, on cabriole legs, height 134cm, width 76cm, depth 47cm.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,000

Condition Report

2180. The general condition is quite good with little disturbance to much of the boulework. There is one line of brass stringing that has lifted and one small area of brass inlay that has lifted on the right hand side of the horizontal surface. There is also some minor surface cracking to the ebonized veneer, but otherwise the condition is ok.
