A Prattware figure of a classical lady leaning on an obelisk, circa 1800, raised on a stepped rectangular base, applied 'Jonathan Horne' paper labels to base, height 20cm. Note: a similar figure is illustrated by John and Griselda Lewis in 'Pratt Ware 1780-1840', p.274.

Condition Report

1408. Typical crazing to glaze. Haircrack running horizontally through middle of base visibly primarily to underside but once spotted you can find it on the top of the base just in front of the obelisk. Starcrack to lower body of figure. A few minor chips primarily to base. Restored through neck.
