74. Relined, cleaned and restored. Previous cleans have left the paint very 'thin' particularly to the flesh tones. Craquelure throughout. UV examination highlights overpainting throughout, particularly the diaphanous dress which is a later addition. Frame with some scuffs and scratches to extremities.
