A Vincennes bleu lapis ground porcelain cup and saucer, circa 1750, the cup gilt with a foliate spray between laurel bands and a scrolling ribbon to the rim, spaced with stylized leaves, unmarked, diameter of saucer 11.5cm. 1424. Saucer - heavy scratching to interior, some wear to gilt, firing crack to underside of base.
Cup - light surface scratching, some wear to gilt particularly to rim and central floral spray.
