A late Victorian brass four-branch ceiling light, in the manner of W.A.S. Benson, the central stem issuing scrollwork mounts and a pierced circlet supporting four branches, height 123cm, width 74cm (originally fitted as a gas light but converted to electricity, some faults).

Condition Report

4125. There are two of the scroll mounts detached but it appears as though they were made in separate sections and need re-attaching with some form of restoration. There are a few screw heads missing throughout the frame and otherwise there is overall surface scratches.
