LOT 1010

A Chinese Canton silk covered album of twelve export watercolour paintings on rice paper, mid-19th century, each finely painted in vibrant colours, depicting a processional scene, 20cm x 33cm (one badly damaged, others with minor faults).

Estimate: £600 - £900

Condition Report

1010. Overall in generally good condition with good vibrant colours, all with some minor staining to background.

Image 1 - very poor condition, in numerous pieces with tears.

Image 2 - 7cm tear to upper right corner, very small tear across lower left corner.

Image 3 - tear to top right and lower right corners, 10 and 8cm vertical tears to centre of image.

Image 4 - tear to lower right and left hand corners, otherwise good.

Image 5 - tear to upper right corner and tiny tear to right edge, otherwise good.

Image 6 - tear to right lower corner, small tear to lower edge, otherwise good.

Image 7 - tear to bottom corners and edge, and a few horizontal creases to paper.

Image 8 - tear to bottom lower right corner and some minor discolouration marks, otherwise good.

Image 9 - small tears to right hand corners and 2.5cm tear to top edge, a few minor nicks to paper but otherwise good.

Image 10 - tears to upper and lower right hand corners, small tear to lower edge, and a few discolouration marks, otherwise good.

Image 11 - tear to upper and lower right hand corners, 4cm tear to lower edge and a couple of small holes to lower part of image, otherwise good.

Image 12 - tears to upper and lower right hand corners, some crinkling to paper, otherwise in good order.
