A group of six Chinese hardwood stands, late Qing dynasty and later, including a carved and pierced tripod censer stand of lotus form, width 15.7cm, a square hardwood stand with carved and pierced apron, width 10.2cm, and a small hardwood stand with carved foliate apron, diameter 10cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1023. Carved and pierced tripod censer stand - 15.7cm wide, generally in good condition, a few very minor nicks to high points but no significant damage or repairs.

Square stand - 10.2cm, in good condition, no damage or repair.

Small carved stand - 10cm, one foot with minor repair, otherwise in good condition.

Large carved stand - 16.5cm diameter, generally in good condition, some wear to polish, minor scuffs and scratches and a few minor nicks to high points.

Carved circular stand - 13.5cm diameter, in good condition, no significant damage or repairs.

Small turned circular stand - 9cm diameter, in good condition, no repairs or damage.
