A small group of Chinese ivory carvings, late 19th/early 20th century, including a Canton paperknife with figural handle, length 26cm, a Canton 'puzzleball' and stand, height 19cm, a Canton bangle carved with dragons, diameter 7.5cm, and a figure of a fisherman, height 19cm, together with an Indian ivory figure, height 10.8cm (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1076. Paperknife - generally in good condition, blade slightly warped.

Bangle - shrinkage crack across width, otherwise in good condition.

Fisherman - in good condition.

Puzzle ball and stand - ball appears to be in generally good condition with typical nicks and minor chips to high points, stand also appears to be in reasonable condition with a small split to pierced cylindrical base.

Seal - in generally good condition, couple of very minor chips to high points.

Indian figure - in good condition, possibly missing finial to hat.

Chess piece - broken and repaired.
