A Japanese Satsuma earthenware two-handled pot, by Kinkozan, Meiji period, of compressed circular form, the upper section painted and gilt with opposing figural scenes, the lower with leaves, all between simulated brocade borders, impressed signature seal mark to base, height 6cm (minor hairline to rim).
