A Japanese Satsuma earthenware bowl, Meiji period, of steep sided circular form, the interior enamelled with a blue dragon beneath a border of blue, red and gilt kiku mon, the exterior with a band of blue bamboo beneath swathes of gilt clouds, enamelled indistinct signature and Shimazu mon to base, height 12cm.
