### LOT 1123

A Japanese Imari porcelain vase, early 18th century, the baluster body painted and gilt with chrysanthemum, height 23.5cm (repaired neck), together with a Japanese Satsuma earthenware vase of square baluster form, painted and gilt with a landscape, height 15.5cm, a Japanese iron red and blue decorated porcelain dish, diameter 18.6cm, an Imari bowl and two yellow and blue wine cups (some faults).

### Condition Report

1123. Imari vase - small starcrack to base, 5 by 2cm U-shaped section of rim broken out and re-glued, some crazing to glaze and typical wear to gilt.

Satsuma vase - in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration, minor wear to gilding.

Japanese dish - starcrack to base and slight staining, wear and scratches to decoration.

Imari bowl - 4cm hairline and chip to rim

2 teabowls - in good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration.
