A Japanese carved ivory okimono figure group of a mother and child, Meiji period, modelled with the mother carrying the child on her back, height 14.3cm, together with a Japanese carved ivory and inlaid red lacquer okimono figure of a street vendor, Meiji period, modelled carrying a selection of drums and toys, incised red lacquer signature plaque to base, height 14cm (some faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1149. Maiden and boy - generally in good condition. Boy's left hand broken at wrist and his thumb is missing, the maiden appears to have originally held something in right hand which is now missing. Small chip to rattle in boy's right hand. Base split in 2 and repaired with a later ivory panel.
Street vendor - repaired and restored right hand and drum which is slung over right shoulder. There are a couple of peg holes visible where other elements would have been fixed, small section of rope missing between left hand and drum, other minor chips.
