A Japanese carved ivory okimono figure, Meiji/Taisho period, finely modelled as a samurai warrior wearing full armour and wielding a sword, incised and stained signature to base, height 12cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

1150. Generally in good condition with finely carved detail. Left hand sectional replacement. Finial on top of helmet possibly later. Repair to hilt of sword with some glue residue visible. Minor repair to scabbard. Typical shrinkage cracks to base.
