A Japanese carved ivory okimono figure of a scholar, Meiji period, modelled seated on an oval base, inset red lacquer signature plaque to base, height 5.2cm, together with another Japanese carved ivory okimono figure group of two men holding a scroll, height 6.7cm, and a Japanese carved and stained ivory okimono netsuke, modelled as a female warrior, height 6.7cm.

1162. Seated scholar - chip to corner of scroll, empty peg hole to chest probably missing element, some glue residue visible where different elements fixed.

Two men - generally in good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

Female warrior - generally in good condition with no significant damage or repairs.
