An Indian export ivory part chess set, 19th century, one side stained brown, the other left natural, comprising eighteen pieces with finely carved detail, height of king 11cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1168. The set is in generally good condition with some very minor typical nicks to base edges and high points, and some wear to brown staining. The brown King is missing its finial and one brown pawn is a darker colour and possibly repaired. One white Knight has a repaired ear and nose, otherwise in generally good order. As well as the 18 pieces there is in addition one stem section of a brown pawn.
