Two Japanese silk embroidered rectangular panels, early 20th century, each finely worked in coloured threads, one depicting a Torii (Shinto temple gateway) in a landscape, $21.5 \, \text{cm} \times 29.5 \, \text{cm}$, the other with a river scene, bridge, trees and pavillions, $21 \, \text{cm} \times 28.5 \, \text{cm}$, both framed and glazed.
