A rare Chinese cinnabar lacquered Yixing stoneware teapot and cover, late Qing dynasty, the compressed circular body carved in reverse with a pair of opposing dragons amidst vapours, beneath a keyfret band rim, the cover with a pair of bats and vapours, impressed three character mark to interior of cover, height 11.4cm, length 20cm (repair of handle).

1189. Cover in generally good condition with some typical light surface wear. The teapot body in generally good condition with typical light surface wear and scratches, the spout with typical wear and restored chip to underside, the handle has been broken at top, middle and bottom and restored.
