A collection of mostly South-east Asian works of art, late 19th century and later, including a Japanese silk embroidered panel depicting cockerels, 122cm x 72.5cm, a Chinese hardwood mounted table mirror and stand, height 22cm, a Chinese mother-of-pearl inlaid hardwood ruler, length 39cm, a coral and white metal necklace and a Tibetan prayer book, the wooden covers painted with bodhisattva, length 32cm (faults).

### Condition Report

1250. Panel - in poor condition with major un-stitching, fraying and general wear.

Mirror and stand - split to frame, otherwise okay.

Ruler - two pieces of inlay missing to each end and a couple of other minor chips. The wood with scuffs to edges.

Necklace - with general wear, some misshaping and dents etc.

Prayer book - generally in fair condition, some staining to paper pages but paintings of deities generally bright and vibrant.
