A Japanese Kutani porcelain side plate, Meiji period, typically painted in iron red and gilt with flowers, within a rim of vapours and ho-o roundels, iron red painted mark to base, diameter 20.4cm, together with another Kutani side plate painted with two ducks and flowers in a landscape, diameter 21.5cm.
