A George II mahogany triple leaf fold-over games and tea table, the hinged top with projecting rounded corners, the interior inset with a baize playing surface above an inlaid backgammon and chessboard, the side fitted with a pull-out counter holder, the tapering legs with later carved shoulders and pad feet, height 74.5cm, width 84cm, depth 41cm (some alterations).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2007. The overall appearance and colour of the table is generally quite good, however it has had some repairs and alterations throughout its life. The hinged support on the rear swing leg is an alteration and does not seem to adjust so the top can sit level for backgammon. There are possible changes to the small side drawer and the hinges to the compartment appear to have been changed. The top has some light scuffs and cup marks. The legs have had castors at some point and there is a crack to the base of one foot.
