An early 20th century George III style mahogany triple pedestal dining table with boxwood stringing and two extra leaves, raised on turned baluster columns and tripod sabre legs, terminating in brass caps and castors, height 71cm, overall length 327cm, depth 132cm.

Condition Report

2126. The table is in generally good order, with only minor surface scratches and scuffs to the top, a slight colour difference to the two leaves and some old repairs to the leg joints. Structurally sound and sturdy. It does not have support rails and instead just small rotating supports, so both leaves probably not the most stable. All clips are present.
