A William IV needlework sampler by Hannah Meyler, dated Nov. 26 1834, finely worked in coloured silks with cherubs, lions, birds, urns and flowers within a trailing floral border, 47cm x 52cm, within a later oak frame.

Condition Report

2810. The sampler has been worked onto a very delicate muslin which has browned considerably, however it appears to have been backed on to silk and it is this that has split and not the sampler itself. The muslin and silk threads appear to be in good condition with just a few loose threads and some darkening of colours.
