A Regency mahogany and brass bound campaign writing slope, the top inset with a brass plate inscribed 'Mr Millard Master R.N.', fitted with recessed side handles and drawer, width 51cm. Note: Mr Millard is probably George Millard, who was appointed master in the Royal Navy in 1811 and was awarded the Naval General Service Medal. This box is accompanied by a letter from the National Maritime Museum.

Condition Report

2607. There are a few small cracks across the brass mounts, missing mount to rear left lower corner and section of mount missing to front right lower corner. The lid panel has shrunk slightly over time leaving the brass straps across the top to come away slightly. Also a small crack to front left corner of top. Missing pin that holds the side drawer in and otherwise a little cleaned off to the exterior, with marks and wear to interior.
