A George IV mahogany open waterfall bookcase cabinet, the galleried top above three open shelves and a pair of doors, inset with gilt metal trellis panels, all flanked by spiral reeded supports, on spiral reeded legs, height 131cm, width 91cm, depth 31cm.

Condition Report

2013. The bookcase has a brass handle attached with later screws to both sides. The upper right spiral column is loose and there are overall light surface scuffs and scratches. There are a few old repairs to the brass lattice panels and the silk has been replaced with later fitting mouldings holding it in place to the interior. There are numerous historic pin holes around the edges of the inside doors where fabric would have been attached. The lower back panel is slightly warped and needs re-pinning. There is one small piece of moulding damaged and missing to right side of lower trim.
