Condition Report

2140. The needlework has an overall surface wear, with loss to the corners, some loose braiding and loss to the fringing. Small section of knob missing on inside of two legs. Some considerable historic woodworm to one leg and a scattering of other holes to other legs. A few areas of re-gilding to legs.
