## Condition Report

2528. Two of the pillar rivets are loose, but not disconnected, so the 'bell collar' is quite wobbly. Otherwise only some light surface wear and some minor indentations overall. The rack and pinion mechanism appears to be in good working order. There is some light surface rust to the interior screw.
