A 9ct gold and enamelled brooch, designed as a kingfisher, Birmingham 1979 by Cropp & Farr Ltd, length 3cm.

Condition Report

636. There is some damage to the enamel work some of which goes down to the metal - principally to the end of the beak, below the eye, to the top edge of the bird's head, to the wing and to the two wing tips. Professional restoration required to the enamel. The metalwork is otherwise in good condition. The pin hinge looks to be in good condition and original. The folding security hook has some evidence of file marks and does not close completely, it would require professional adjustment.

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
