## LOT 674

An early 19th century garnet and agate oval ring, the oval cabochon agate mounted within a surround of faceted garnets between scroll pierced shoulders, ring size approx L.

Estimate: £250 - £300

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## Condition Report

674. The cabochon agate has probably replaced a glazed hair locket. There is some wear to the surrounding garnets. The ring has been resized at the back in the past. There is a different colour of gold when viewed from the back, the mount of the cluster may be in association with the gold shank and shoulders. There is some evidence of glue to the edge of the agate. One of the garnets has a chip.

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
