Condition Report

340. Frame is in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Good clear hallmarks to underside. Glass bottles in generally good order, the larger caster has a small bruise to underside of its foot. Silver covers with few minor dents and typical wear, but generally ok. Frame only weight 635g. Five lids weight 103g.
