A First World War period French prismatic field monocular telescope, model 1917, with 7.5cm object lens and three-position rotating turret eyepieces giving approx 15x, 23x and 30x magnification, retaining most of its original khaki paint finish (prism cover missing), with its oak tripod mount and leather carrying case, together with copies of research and handbook.

Condition Report

1925. Lenses appear dirty and require a clean. As mentioned in description, prism cover is missing, but lenses appear to work. The body appears to be aluminium, with some overall scuffs and wear to painted surface.
