Condition Report

1800. All weather guard parted at stitched seam. Overall wear to leather work, cracks, perished etc. Paint bubbling along scabbard surface, although stable. Blade edge chipped in one or two places. Hilt loose, fabric binding to hilt worn, peg lacking.
