A mid-20th century plated model of an R.A.F. Lancaster bomber, raised on a lightning bolt stem and ebonized plinth, bearing presentation plaque inscribed 'Presented to Air Vice Marshal E.B. Addison C.B. C.B.E. by the officers and airmen of the Signals Development Unit February 1949', height 23.5cm.

Condition Report

395. The plane itself is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. The plating is a bit tarnished and a little dirty but it should probably clean up. The only real damage is some loss to the wirework which is detached on one side and missing on the other and some minor misshaping to wirework on top and guns at front. Base has a few scuffs, but otherwise good.
