A late Victorian 18ct gold, sapphire and diamond five stone ring, claw set with three cushion shaped sapphires alternating with two cushion shaped diamonds, Birmingham 1899, ring size approx O.

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

651. The ring is in generally good condition commensurate with age. There is no significant damage or repairs. Good clear hallmarks. Typical light surface scratches and wear to mount. Typical surface abrasions to stones visible under magnification. The piece would benefit from a clean. Sapphires are well matched in colour. Diamonds have some internal inclusions visible under magnification and one has a surface reaching inclusion to the side of the stone.

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
