371. Compact - personally engraved to underside - in good condition. stiff to open, but closes flush with good hinge.

2 napkin rings - both with personal engraved inscriptions, one a bit misshapen, other with tiny dent.

Ring - very misshapen, shank cut, decoration rubbed, surface deterioration.
