A Victorian naval officer's sword with straight single-edged fullered blade by Simpson & Rook, London, blade length 72.5cm, gilt brass hilt with lion's head pommel and folding guard, wire-bound fishskin grip and bullion dress knot, with gilt brass-mounted leather scabbard, outer black leather case and belt.

Condition Report

1799. The scabbard has some minor overall surface wear and also a slight kink to the end of the leather. The blade has an are of surface rust to rear edge and other overall minor surface wear. Areas of wear to surface of bullion know and thread, as well as an overall light surface wear to hit and handle.
