An 18ct gold half-hunting cased gentleman's chronograph pocket watch, the gilt jewelled movement detailed 'Russells Limited, Makers to the late Queen 18, Church Street Liverpool', 'Time O'Day Trade Mark' and numbered '88804', the similarly signed enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and centre seconds, the 18ct inner case back with engraved presentation inscription, the case front with blue enamelled Roman numerals, London 1920, case diameter 5.1cm, with original brown leather case.
