A Rolex Oyster Perpetual Day-Date 18ct gold cased gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, circa 1970, model number 1803, the signed gilt dial with baton hour markers, day aperture at 12 o'clock, date aperture at 3 o'clock and detailed 'Rolex Oyster Perpetual Day-Date Superlative Chronometer Officially Certified', Rolex crown to winding button, on a gold mesh link tapering bracelet with Rolex fold-over clasp, detailed '18k', case diameter 3.6cm.

Condition Report

1010. Watch is in very good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Looks to have had very little wear as original model number sticker is still present on the case back. Winding button screws in nice and tight. Only typical very minor surface scratches and only really visible under magnification. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently in good working order with date and day features working as they should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Marked between the lugs at 12 o'clock 'Registered Design 1803' and at 6 o'clock '2384630'.

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
