A Rolex Oyster Perpetual Air-King steel gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, circa 1972, Ref. No. 5500, the signed silvered dial with silvered baton hour markers, Rolex crown at 12 o'clock and centre seconds, Rolex crown to winding button, detailed between the lugs 'Registered Design 5500' and 'Stainless Steel 2975104', case diameter 3.3cm, the Rolex bracelet with fold-over clasp, detailed '78350 19 557', together with green leather box, guarantee certificate, dated '7.3.72', and service history.

1025. The watch is in generally good condition. Currently working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Winds and adjusts smoothly and winding button screws in nice and tightly. The dial is generally good, but does have a very small scratch just to the left of centre at 9 o'clock. Lettering is good and bold. Case in generally good condition with typical surface scratches. Glass is also scratched. The bracelet is also scratched and worn with one link broken. Quite dirty so would benefit from a clean.
