A Rolex 18ct gold cushion case gentleman's mid-size wristwatch, circa 1927, the signed jewelled movement detailed 'Rolex Extra Prima, 15 Jewels, timed 6 positions for all climates, Swiss Made', the silvered circular dial with black Arabic hour numerals and subsidiary seconds, the cushion case with milled front and screw back, the signed case back interior numbered '20925' and detailed '18c', case width 2.8cm, on a brown leather strap.

Condition Report

1030. The watch does not wind or run. The 'Oyster Patent' winding button screws in nice and tightly, but when unscrewed it becomes loose and comes away from the watch. The dial is generally in good order with some light wear and discolouration. Glass is scratched. Case in generally good condition with good definition to milled front and back, typical surface scratches and wear commensurate with age. Very small pin-prick sized dent to case back. Strap is worn.

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
