A Rolex Prince 9ct yellow and white gold rectangular curved cased gentleman's wristwatch, the signed jewelled 'Extra Prima' movement numbered '76663', with signed 'Protective Cap' dust cover, the silvered rectangular dial with Arabic numerals, subsidiary seconds and detailed 'Rolex Prince', the case back numbered '73588' over '971u', import mark Glasgow 1930, case width 2.5cm, case length including lugs 4.3cm, on a later leather strap, together with a Rolex green leather box.

Condition Report

1050. The watch is in generally good condition. It winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The winder does not have logo. The dial is a little worn and marked with some dirt spots and some wear particularly through the 'Rolex' lettering. The case is in generally good order with typical light surface wear and scratches commensurate with age. Both lower corners of yellow gold have worn through and have very small holes. Glass with typical scratches. The movement is detailed '15 Rubies'.
Case width 2.5cm, case length including lugs 4.3cm, case length excluding lugs 3.7cm, depth including glass 1cm.

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
