## LOT 1058

A Le Cheminant Master Mariner steel cased gentleman's chronograph wristwatch with jewelled movement, the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers, three subsidiary dials and outer tachymeter and telemeter track, framed by a rotating bezel, the case back numbered '2003' and '15048', case diameter 4cm, on an expanding bracelet.

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## Condition Report

1058. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and chrono features appear to be working but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The top chrono button starts and stops and the bottom button returns the centre seconds to between 3 and 4 o'clock. The dial is generally ok, but under magnification you can see some minor dirt specks and spots. Lettering and detail are good. The bezel has some wear and some loss to the black enamel band particularly between 10 and 12 o'clock, and on a smaller scale at 1 o'clock. Glass with typical surface scratches. The case is in generally good order with typical light surface wear and scratches, but no significant damage or repairs.

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
