A First World War period MoD issue nickel cased gentleman's wristwatch with unsigned jewelled movement, numbered '82111', the black dial with luminous Arabic hours and subsidiary seconds, the Dennison Watch Co. case with milled screw-on front and back, the signed case back interior numbered '204965', the case back detailed '21014 C' below MoD arrow, case diameter 3.5cm, on a leather strap.

### Condition Report

1016. The watch appears to wind smoothly but it does not run even with a gentle shake. Also the watch does not adjust the hands.

Dial is in generally good order but is a bit pitted and the luminous detail is a bit worn.

Case has typical wear and a couple of small dents to case back.
