An Enicar Jet Graph Sherpa 300 stainless steel cased gentleman's chronograph wristwatch, circa 1968, Ref. No. 0072-02-02, the signed black dial with luminous tipped white hour markers, centre seconds and three subsidiary dials, with rotating 24 hour bezel, the signed case back with Sherpa 300 emblem and numbered '314962' and '907122' above '072-02-02', case diameter 4cm, on an expanding bracelet.

Condition Report

1090. The watch is currently in good working order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The chronograph functions all seem to be in working order.

The centre seconds stop and start with the upper button and resets with the lower button.

The left subsidiary dial is a continuous seconds dial which is unaffected by buttons.

The right subsidiary minute dial clicks forward correctly when the centre seconds completes a circuit and both return to zero with chronograph button reset.

The watch winds and adjusts but is a little stiff when doing so.

The dial appears to be in good clean condition with no significant damage. There are a few very minor spots/specks visible under magnification and some minor corrosion/rusting to the hands.

The case has some typical wear and surface scratches. The bezel has more significant wear and scratches and is missing the marker.
