Condition Report

1151. The clock and movement have obviously been involved in an accident at some stage. The extra shots online show everything regarding the movement. It winds smoothly but it is very dirty and would need to be cleaned to run properly. The bell is missing. The dial is a bit worn with some craquelure and chips to edges. Both scale fret panels are present.
