A mid-18th century yew chest-on-chest, the top and drawer fronts with crossbanded borders, height 127cm, width 115cm, depth 59cm (formerly painted and stripped, faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

2017. As is apparent from the images, the chest is in overall poor condition. It appears to have been stripped, having been previously painted, leaving a dry unfinished surface throughout. There is a section of yew that has been worn down to the oak carcass on the top. Overall small areas of loss to veneers throughout the chest and lacking locks to drawers. The interiors of the drawers and the back panels still have a painted surface. There is evidence of some minor woodworm, but this is minor compared to the rest of the issues.
