A Queen Anne provincial oak chest of drawers with applied brass pear shaped handles, raised on turned bun feet, height 88cm, width 95cm, depth 49cm.

Condition Report

2002. The top has an area of minor cracking to front left corner and there are some other fairly typical surface cracks to top. The handles, which are good replacements, are fitted through the original holes, however there are other small filled-in holes to each side of the handle. The feet are good later replacements and been placed within the original holes. There is some evidence of minor woodworm to the lower area of the back panels and the moulded trim on the left side appears to have been replaced.
