A mid-19th century ash, beech and fruitwood-seated provincial Windsor armchair, possibly Scottish, the bar and stick back above a thick solid seat with remnants of historic red paint, on turned legs, height 110cm, width 558cm, depth 66cm.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

2055. General surface and structural condition is good, with an overall waxed finish with areas of good colour and patina. Evidence of some minor historic woodworm to the centre of the hoop and one spindle. Overall typical surface scuffs, dents and wear, mainly to legs and stretchers, but what you would want to see on an old chair. Seat height slopes front to back - 44cm at front to 41cm at back.
