An early 20th century Indian carved hardwood model of an elephant wearing a howdah on its back, raised on a petal carved rectangular base, height 44cm, width 46cm.

Condition Report

2574. The general condition and appearance is good, with a few small overall repairs. The tail and both tusk areas have had minor re-glued repairs, one of the rope supports is slightly loose towards the end. There is a repaired crack along one tusk and a thin hairline crack to one foot. Otherwise just a few minor scuffs and marks. Base bears inscription.
