A late 19th/early 20th century enamelled propelling pencil, the shaft painted with a cherub playing a lyre, length 4.5cm.

Condition Report

2432. The enamel shaft appears to be in good order. The gilt metal case is quite worn and there is a thin collar that should be tight to the end of the enamel, this is loose. The pull-out operation works ok but needs some help when drawing the pen back in. The tip has an added mount which is probably 1mm diameter. There is also an area of slight loss to the gilt metal nib area.
